Stage of school improvement journey

Key leadership qualities

Phase 1: Stabilise

- School requires significant improvement
- No clear underpinning for the future

- Calm and reassuring leadership
- Focusing on urgent priorities
- Ensuring team members have the right jobs
- High visibility

Phase 2: Repair

- Establishing more control
